

## Dialogue on Race Timeline 2006-January 2014

<b>2006</b>	Community Group founded by Penny Franklin & Rev. John Price
<b>2009-2010</b>	The Community Group begins the process of gathering people to form a work group to help fund a Dialogue on Race
<b>2010-2012</b>	Steering Committee for Dialogue on Race formed: Penny Franklin, chair; Dave Britt, Ben Dixon, Jim Dubinsky, Andy Morikawa, Ray Plaza, Wornie Reed, and Latanya Walker
<b>October 2011 to April 2012</b>	African-American community members in Montgomery County, VA meet and talk four times (facilitated by Dr. Wornie Reed)
<b>January 2013</b>	First Dialogue on Race Summit Six Issue Groups formed (later reduced to five): Education, Law Enforcement, Jim Crow, Limited Presence, Income Gap, Jobs & Employment.
<b>January 2013 to June 2013</b>	Issue Groups begin work
<b>June 2013</b>	Dialogue on Race: Projects Development
<b>June 2013 to January 2014</b>	Issue Groups continue work; Steering Committee plans for 2 <sup>nd</sup> Summit
